Resolution to approve the Submission of a Grant Proposal to Renovate a Shared Senior Center in Geraldine

The Geraldine Town Council and the Honorable Mayor, Chuck Ables, sitting in General session and representing the approximately 896 souls of the town of Geraldine, do hereby propose the following resolution in support of a grant proposal to secure Community Enhancement Block Grant funding, (see **budget page for specific amounts**), provided by the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs to renovate a shared senior center for the town of Geraldine.

WHEREAS, the current senior center for the town of will be used once monthly by the Homemakers' Club for a meetings and once annually for quilt shows

WHEREAS, the center has non-ADA compliant bathrooms, inadequate lighting, a non-ADA compliant ramp for main entry, 70s-era dark paneling, inadequate parking, no all-weather portico for bus unloading, no covered entry-way, non-ADA kitchen fixtures, inadequate storage

WHEREAS, an improved facility will increase the participation rate of area seniors

WHEREAS, a renovated center will bring the facility into ADA compliance in the areas mentioned


WHEREAS, a renovated center will optimize the overall psychological and physical well-being of area seniors

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the town of Geraldine, Alabama hereby authorizes the submission of a CDBG grant application


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be included as an item in the final grant submission.
